The center houses exhibits on all of New Mexico's 19 living Indian Pueblos. This afternoon we enjoy a delightful lunch at one of Albuquerque's local favorite restaurants – El Pinto. A Few Words About Travel Insurance

For nearly 30 years we have encouraged our travelers to purchase trip cancellation and interruption insurance when they plan a trip. We actually price the insurance into any cruise or *out of US* trips for your convenience. (see the Nova Scotia write-up)

You might not realize that once we receive your final payment on an overnight tour we disperse these funds to our contractors on your behalf. Those funds become nonrefundable at that point. Sometimes health issues crop up that you did not anticipate and cause you to cancel your trip. Occasionally we can resell the space and refund your money but often we can't and it is really sad to see one of our clients lose those funds. So we encourage you to consider purchasing the insurance so that you can get your money back if you can't make the trip. We provide information on various policies to each person who makes a deposit with us for a tour and again with the final payment billings.

We provide information on two types of insurance coverage – one that provides coverage to folks dealing with preexisting medical conditions and one for folks who might want to cover just those unexpected illnesses. You can buy these policies via the mail, over the phone or on-line. Or better yet, call us and let us give you a quote on the cost. It is not fun to miss a trip but it is even worse to lose the money!

Pleasurebent Tours Important Information

HOW DO YOU MAKE A RESERVATION?

Our newsletter is mailed to over 5,000 people on a quarterly basis. This is our only source of advertising. When you receive a newsletter, call our office and give us the name of the trip that you would like to book, number of people in your party, and your name and phone number. If, by the time your call is received, we are already full on the trip that you wanted, we will offer to put you on a waiting list.

HOW DO YOU PAY FOR THE TOUR?

We ask that you mail us a deposit to confirm your reservation (\$80.00 per person for tours 4 days or shorter and \$150.00 per person for tours 5 days or longer). If we do not receive this deposit within 1 week after your reservation was made, we reserve the right to resell the space - due to high demand. Final payments are usually due 60 to 45 days prior to the departure of the tour. *(Call for specific tour policy.)*

If you book your trip after the final payment date, full payment is due within 2 days of the booking. If you book a fly-out after the final payment date, you may be subject to a package price increase to cover airline price increases. Pleasurebent Tours reserves the right to pass on "fuel charges" as well as air fare increases and currency fluctuations.

WE DO NOT ACCEPT CREDIT CARDS.

WHAT IS OUR CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY? Deposits are refundable up to the final payment date (less a \$30.00 per person administration fee for 4 days or shorter or a \$50.00 per person administration fee for 5 days or longer.) If there are nonrefundable tickets involved we will withhold that amount from the deposit refund as well. We cannot guarantee a refund after the final payment date of the overnight tour you have reserved unless we resell the space.
